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Report on the celebration of "International Yoga Day




Objectives- International Yoga Day is celebrated every year on 21st June. This day is the longest day of the year and yoga also makes a person live longer.

FIELD TRIP TO SHRI KARAN NARENDRA AGRICULTURE UNIVERSITY, SITUATED IN JOBNER

Executive summary -

Excursions are arranged to give exposure to students. Field education is equally important as classroom teaching. It adds vigour in learning processes and relieves monotones of indoor education. Field study is an essential part of botany as plants are best studied in their natural habitat. These tours also help to build good repo amongst students and teachers. Students collected and studied plants for herbarium preparation under the guidance of **Dr. YOGITA TYAGI**. The trip successfully inculcated in students the practicality of different theoretical concepts of Botany.

INTRODUCTION:

M.SC. BOTANY students (20 numbers) along with three faculty members of S.S.G. PAREEK COLLEGE, BANIPARK, JAIPUR Visited JOBNER AGRICULTURE UNIVERSITY on **15 MARCH 2021**. This visit was organized to study the biodiversity and to collect plant specimens such as angiosperms for herbarium, algae, bryophytes, etc. for submission in practical examination.

TRIP OBJECTIVES:

The main objective behind taking student to the visit was to go beyond academics. It gave student a practical perspective on the internal working of the department of agriculture. It provides them an opportunity to learn practically through interaction.

FIELD OBSERVATION:

Guided Tour: The visit began with a guided tour led by experienced botanists and staff. They provided insightful information about the diverse plant collections. Students were introduced to various sections of the university, each representing different activity & function with specific Students had the opportunity to observe a wide range of plants, from towering trees to delicate orchids. Visitors were captivated by the meticulously designed landscapes, themed gardens, and artistic plant arrangements. Thereafter, students were taken to different laboratories and Technology Demonstration Centre, field observation.

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

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


Objective -"Blood donation is a noble act" If our blood can give life to someone, then what can be more happiness in our life than that.

On 13 March 2021, S.S.G PAREEK COLLEGE students actively participated in parinda abhiyan activity.



- 10. The idea behind the tree plantation activity was to spread the message that planting the tree helps to maintain clear eco friendly environment reduces pollution and improves the green ambience.





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
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"Report on awareness program about HIV on "World AIDS Day"



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REPORT ON

TRAINING PROGRAM AT KAPOOR CHANDRA KULISH SMRITI VAN

ABOUT THE TRAINING PLACE:

Smriti Van in Jaipur is a vast area of JHALANA GAME RESERVE. Located in the heart of Jaipur on JLN Marg, Kapoor Chandra Kulish Smriti Van is spread over an estimated 108 hectares area.

<u>INTRODUCTION</u> – Training program was conducted for a week. it was started from 07-09-2020. Training given by experienced botanist & field experts. General training topics overlap only partially with the routine assistance that participants will give to staff in the areas of curation and research.

The Roles of Herbaria and Botanic Gardens

Research; education; conservation; public information; scientific vouchering; archival techniques for vascular and non-vascular plants; museum standards for biological collections.

Field Techniques

Site and specimen selection; specimen processing; assessing habitat including vegetation, geology, soils; field data recording; map reading and geo code determination; field equipment and field safety; permits and access protocols; propagation material.

Biological Databases

Uses of databases, maintaining data standards and data entry. Taxonomic Techniques, Revisions and Sources of Botanical Information Theoretical approaches; classification systems; sources of data; practical uses; basic information sources in the literature; curation following recent revisionary studies; major databases; areas of expertise; scientific naming - principles and the International Code of Botanical Nomenclature

Plant Identification

General techniques; use of printed and interactive keys; practical identification work.

work. PRINCIPAL S.S.G. PAREEK PG COLLEGE JAIPUR (RAJASTHAN)

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Objective of training program -

Botanical Training Program is designed to allow students of botany, environmental science and related subjects the opportunity for substantive scientific work experience. Participants assist with various Centre programs and receive both task-specific training and general botanical training. Work sessions are designed to give students a feel for life in the scientific workforce. Training sessions complement academic studies with both botanical and general workforce-skills components. All participants will undertake the common training sessions. Students with serious specific interests or experience in bryophytes, lichens, orchids, eucalypts and botanical databases are especially encouraged to apply.

Field observations during training program -

The Kulish Smiriti Van is divided into following 11 Sections: -

- 1. Vasundhra Van: The Vasundhara Van is the main attraction of Smirti Van. Aromatic plants like 'Mogra', Champa etc. and other plants like Almonda, Coral tree have been planted in this section.
- 2. Eco-Environment Museum: There are four halls in the museum section where photograph of birds and flowers found in the 'Smriti Van' have been displayed. One hall is kept for viewing films on nature & wild life.
- 3. Vrindavan Van: This contain exemplary work on drainage line treatment wherein slopes have been stabilized by spreading nets and planting plants in them. The flow of water has been controlled by using boulders. To get rid of foul smell 'Mogra', 'Juhi and Rat Rani plants have also been planted. Champa and other flowering plant have also been planted in Nala bed.
- 4. 'Maru Van: Xerophytic plants like cactus, Euphorbia, Agave and Succulent plants in good numbers have been planted in this 'Van'. The hilly area of this land will completely be covered by these plants as the time passes. At present Euphorbia flowers are main attraction for the visitors. 64 species of this kind of plants have been planted.
- 5. Aravali Van: Efforts have been made to plant various species of plants found in Aravali hill range mainly Dhak, Dhavada, Saalar, Gurjan Hawan, Rohida, Khejdi, Gugal, Gangan etc.
- **6. Sarovar:** Water from Jawahar Nagar Kachi Basti Nala flowing in eastern part of Smriti Van and stored in this "Sarovar" goes to Vrindavan. This area has been dug 5 ft. Deep, and for storing water, nine ponds have been constructed. In these ponds different varieties of Lotus have been placed. Fishes and Ducks have also been put. Immigrant Birds have increased in good numbers in this area during winter.

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- 7. Rastriya Van: Representative plant species of the country have been planted in this 'Van' like. 'Semal, Tibubua Species, Shisham, Paras Peepal, Ficus Ali, different species of Almanda, Gambhari, Kachnar, Rose wood, Beringtonia, Sita Ashok (Yellow as well as Red) Militia, Sinduri, Colvelia, Akash Neem, Mahuwa, Puttranjeeva, Floss Rajni, Spathodia, Cherry, Tehoma, Gooseberry, Siras, Brasia, Arjun, Lagerstroemia etc. Flowering trees and shrubs like Almonda, Bougainvillea, Sada Bahar have been planted along the inspection path and Bouganvilla have been planted on each of old tortoise tree for beautification of the plantation area.
- 8. Champa Van: 108 varieties of Champa Plants have been planted in this van. These plants produce flowers of different colours and fragrance.
- 9. Java Kusum Van: About 68 varieties of Gudhal (Hibiscus) Plants brought from all over the country have been planted in this section. Flowers of different colour shape and size are worth seeing.
- 10. Hi-tech Nursery: To maintained variety and quality of plants a Hi-tech nursery is being developed.
- 11. Dhanvantri Van: This is the largest section of the van which is spread over 40 acres of land and developed as a herbal garden. More than 225 species of medicinal trees shrubs, herbs & climbers have been planted in this section. Tree species like Bahera, Amla, Neem, Arjun, Maulsari, Bel, Kathal, Sandalwood, Kachnar, Lasura, Gular, Rudraksha, Jamun, Sita Ashok, Guggal, Putranjeeva, Giloe, Akarkara, Gokhru, Ghritkumari, Ashwagandha, Sarpagandha, Tulsi, Mehndi, Bhringraj, Bansa etc. Learning Outcomes Core competency: Students will acquire core competency in the subject Botany, and in allied subject.

A certificate of participation and a personal employment reference are supplied upon completion of the Program.

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
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


